Strawberry Shortcake Cupcakes

12 cupcakes

🕒 45 mins

Ingredients

CAKE

- 1 cup plus 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 2 tablespoons cornstarch
- 1 1/4 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar
- 2 large eggs, at room temperature
- 1 1/4 teaspoons pure vanilla extract
- 4 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted
- 1/4 cup vegetable oil
- 1/2 cup milk, at room temperature

Frosting and Topping

- 6 tablespoons unsalted butter, softened
- 2 cups confectioners' sugar, sifted
- 1/2 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- Pinch of salt
- 2 tablespoons milk or heavy cream
- Strawberry jam

Directions

Step 1: Preheat the oven to 350°. Line a 12-cup muffin tin with paper or foil liners.

Step 2: In a medium bowl, whisk the flour with the cornstarch, baking powder and salt.

Step 3: In a large bowl, using a handheld electric mixer, beat the sugar with the eggs and vanilla extract at medium-high speed until smooth and thickened slightly, about 3 minutes. Add the butter and oil and beat until incorporated, scraping the bottom and side of the bowl. Add the dry ingredients and milk in 3 alternating batches, beating well between additions. Carefully pour the batter into the lined muffin tins, filling them about two-thirds full.

Step 4: Bake the cupcakes in the center of the oven for 20 to 23 minutes, until springy and a toothpick or cake tester inserted in the center comes out clean. Let the cupcakes cool slightly in the muffin tin, then transfer them to a wire rack to cool completely.

Step 5: In a medium bowl, using a handheld electric mixer, beat the softened butter at medium speed until smooth. Add the confectioners' sugar, vanilla extract and salt and beat the mixture at low speed just until combined. Increase the mixer speed to medium and beat until smooth. Add the milk or heavy cream and beat until light and fluffy, about 2 minutes.

Step 6: Mix the frosting with strawberry jam to taste. Spread the frosting on the cooled cupcakes and serve.

Prepare ahead

The unfrosted cupcakes can be wrapped in plastic and stored at room temperature for up to 2 days or frozen for up to 1 month. The white buttercream frosting can be refrigerated in an airtight plastic container for up to 2 days. Return to room temperature before using.

McGriddle



YUM

INGREDIENTS:

Sugar glaze

1 cup (240ml) maple syrup

Griddle cakes

1.5 cup (225g) all-purpose flour

2 tsp (9g) baking powder

1 tbsp (14g) sugar

2 tsp (5g) salt

1 egg

1.5 cup milk or 354 ml

2.5 tbsp (28g) melted butter

Per sandwich

1 egg fold

1 sausage patty

1 slice of cheese

INSTRUCTIONS:

Maple Syrup Balls Method:

In a saucepan, bring maple syrup to a bubble.

Pour onto a baking sheet. Spread out evenly. Let it cool down.

Once cooled, cut the maple syrup into little pieces and put it to the side for later.

Put your patty into the pan and sear until done.

In a bowl, combine all-purpose flour, baking powder, sugar, and salt. Whisk together.

While whisking add in whole milk, an egg, and melted butter. Mix until combined.

Heat a nonstick pan to medium heat and add unsalted butter.

Once batter begins to bubble, add in 3 tbsp. of butter. Sprinkle in 4-6 maple syrup balls and poke into batter cooking for 2-3 minutes. Remove the ring mold, flip, and repeat on the other side.

For the folded egg, beat 1 egg in a bowl and place onto a lightly buttered surface medium heated pan.

Spread out to a rectangle using a spatula.

Once cooked three fourth of the way, fold the right side just over, followed by the left side. Finally fold the top and bottom over for a square egg. Remove immediately.

Place griddle back over the pan and place a slice of cheddar cheese and pepper jack cheese on the bottom bun and let it melt.

To serve, top the cheese/bottom bun with the patty, followed by the egg, and place the top bun, which has been brushed with maple syrup, on top.



Minecraft has different editions: "Java Edition", "Bedrock Edition", "Minecraft Dungeons", "Education Edition" and more, though "Java Edition" is known as the best edition. In "Bedrock Edition", the graphics are simpler and there are red mushroom chickens with dandelion cows. You can have more fun if you play it with mods and Texture/Shader packs. You can play Minecraft on your smartphone ("Pocket Edition"), desktop and even on X-box.

Roblox

Roblox has been around since 2006 and is available on smartphones, laptop, tablets and basically almost everywhere. Roblox is okay for users age 13+ and there're many games and servers in Roblox, where you can play with your friends. Some popular games in Roblox are: Adopt me, Tower of Hell, Build a Boat for Treasure, Welcome to Bloxburg, Murder Mystery 2 and Meep City. You can even create your own game in Roblox. FNF



FNF, also known as Friday Night Funkin', has become one of the popular games. The story's about BF trying to impress GF, his girlfriend, and her parents, and protect her from opponents by rap-battling. You have to use arrow keys, WASD or DFJK, to hit the arrows, which will appear at the bottom of your screen and come upwards. The Original Version contains 7 Weeks to battle and each Week has 3 songs to play. In Story Mode, you'll play all 3 songs in row, but in Freeplay, you can pick any song of your choice. FNF has many mods: "Mid-Fight Masses", "Whitty(Full Week)", "Retrospecter", "vs A.G.O.T.I.", ...

Among Us

Among Us, created by Innersloth, is a certain Mafia Game, where there're characters called crewmates, who fix the spaceship and vote for players to be ejected, while 1 or 2 players, known as imposters, kill the crewmates. The game ends with either the crewmates voting out all imposters through an emergency meeting or through dead body reports, or with imposters killing all crewmates before they finish fixing the ship. The imposters can cause sabotage and go through the vents and crewmates can prove, that thy aren't an imposter by some special missions like "Medbay scan".



Among Us has a few mods like the "Medic Mod".

PUBG



PUBG (PlayerUnknown's Battlegrounds), is a shooting game with an age limit of 19+ in Steam, 15+ in Kakao and 13+ on mobile. You get to play with your friends online, but it contains a bit of violence such as shooting guns. The best gun in the game is AWM, which can one-shot everyone if you shoot in the head, even with Lv. 3 helmet. PUBG once had an event, where you could get free chicken dinner if you and your team won. It's also one of the games that has actual competitions with champions from different countries.

Tetris

Tetris is a certain puzzle game that came out in 1984, where different colors and forms of blocks fall from above and you have to stack them correctly, so that your blocks won't get higher than the end-line. If they're over the end-line, the game will obviously end. You can destroy the blocks by filling one line completely. Tetris leads to a thicker cortex and may also increase brain efficiency. Sadly Tetris was discontinued and it won't be renewed.



Coding/Programming tips for beginners

This page can be a great help if you want to know the basics about coding and commands

Coding is the process of transforming ideas, solutions, and instructions into the language that the computer can understand. It's how humans are able to talk with computers.

Just like humans, a computer also has different coding languages: Javascript, HTML, CSS, Python, Java, SQL, R, C and C++ and more. But the 5 main languages are Python, SQL, Javascript, Java and HTML/CSS. Those are the top 5 programming languages.



There are two ways to code: either in blocks or in text. Texts are more complicated and you need to be a little more professional. You can go learn coding from a teacher, but also try it yourself with "Scratch" or "Code.org". In "W3Schools", you can find tutorials and tips. If you think that you can do it alone or already know a lot, then go to "Visual Studio Coding".

It's mostly Python in there and it can be saved into folders.



The difference between coding languages is how you write the code. For example, in Javascript, you'll have to write "var x = 5;", but in Python, you write "x = 5". You have to place semicolons at the end of every code in Javascript, but in Python, you don't. In HTML and CSS, you never write that. Instead, you make website pages out of it.

Since programming and coding require building logic around numbers, mathematics skills are essential for programmers to master. Without an understanding of certain concepts in mathematics, coders and programmers are left without the tools they need to succeed.



Coding and Programming might look the same, though they do have differences:

coding is a part of programming that deals with writing codes that a machine can understand. Programming is a process that creates programs that involve the ratification of codes.

Here are some interesting commands in Minecraft to use:

1. /kill @e[type=.....]
2. /replaceitem entity @s slot.armor.head minecraft:end_rod 1
3. /give @s minecraft: barrier (structure_block, command_block)

Learning how to code isn't a big deal. You just have to think and continue writing codes. It is entirely possible to be a self-taught programmer.



Ouija Origin of Evil:


Ouija Origin of Evil is a really good, really scary horror movie.
